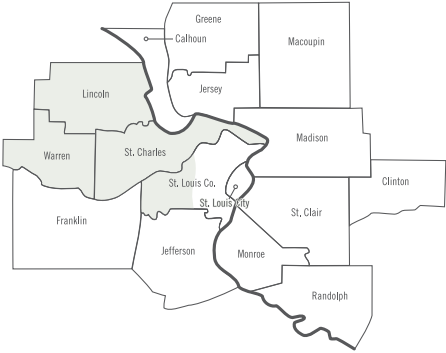


HELPING IN THE WEST REGION

Percentages represent 2018 investments allocated to United Way impact areas.

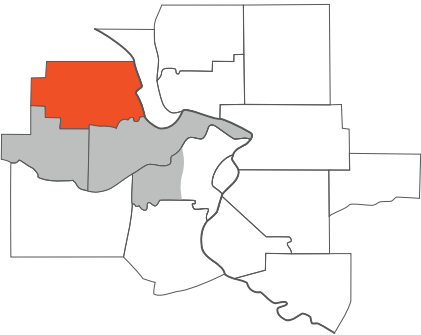
United Way of Greater St. Louis continues to bolster its efforts to effectively identify and address our region’s most pressing needs.

United Way 2-1-1 connects people in your community to the help they need 24/7. Last year, 2-1-1 received **12,198** requests for help from individuals in the West Region.

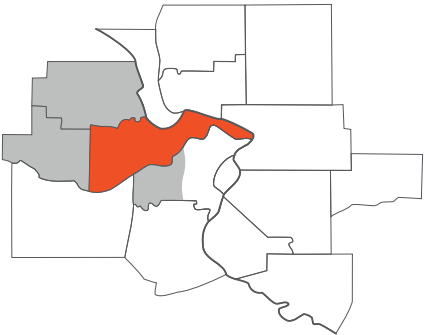

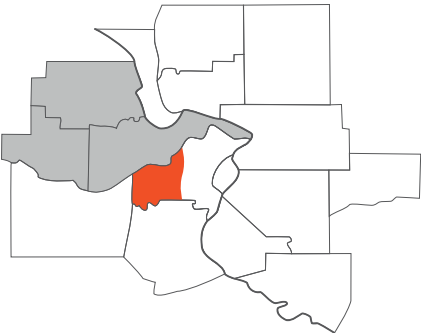

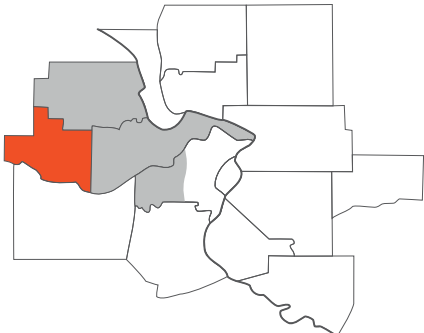
